Tech Talk PRODUCTION TRAINER

Q: I was a guest on a show in Studio A at MetroEast recently, and was curious about the 30-foot wide section of wall that is painted a truly obnoxious shade of bright green. What gives? — *Green-phobic in Gresham*

A: Last month in this article, I began discussing the subject of "keys" in video production. If you missed it, a key is an effect in which parts of two video images are combined into one. For example, when you see a title superimposed over video from a camera, that is one form of key.

The green wall mentioned above is used for creating a key effect which you have probably seen hundreds of times, even if you weren't aware of it. The effect is known by several different names, including "color key", "green screen", or "chroma-key".

One of the better-known uses of the chroma-key is the weather forecast on the news. When you see the weather person standing in front of the big weather map, there's a pretty good chance you're looking at the effect.

In a chroma-key, the purpose of the green color on the background is to help a piece of video equipment (a studio switcher or editing system) distinguish the person standing in front of it (the foreground) from the image you wish to key them into (the background).

Because the switcher/editing system will see any part of the picture that is green as "background", the person in the foreground must not wear clothing that is the same color as the background; a green tie would look like a tie-shaped hole in the subjects' chest.

Although any color can be used as the background color, it's best to avoid colors that are close to skin tones, like red, which might cause part of the face or to disappear. Also, the more "saturated" or vivid the color, the better it will work for the effect.

Good lighting is also important for a quality chroma-key. The green wall should be lit as evenly as possible, without shadows. It's also helpful to keep the subject several feet from the wall, to avoid having green light reflecting on her hair and shoulders. A strong backlight, shining on the subject from above and behind, will help minimize any green reflection. In some cases, the lighting technician may place an amber or yellow "gel" on the backlight to neutralize any green spill.

This three day event culminates in the airing of seasonal programming that showcases our area schools and community groups. See our website and December Lineout program guide for play schedules.

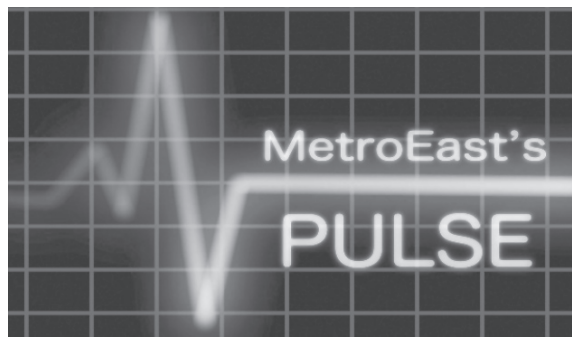
METROEAST'S PULSE
